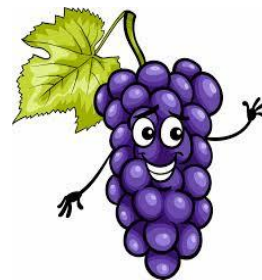

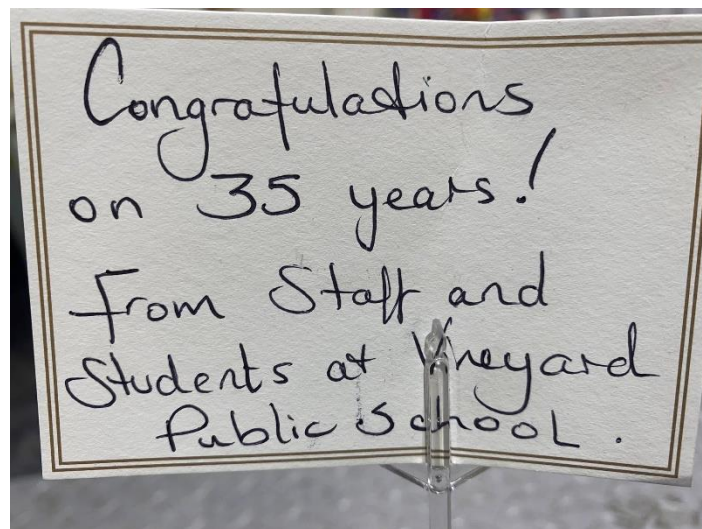

Rouse Hill Bunnings BBQ fundraiser will be on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2022 – 8 am to 4 pm.



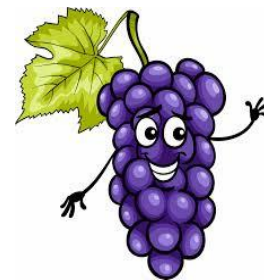
