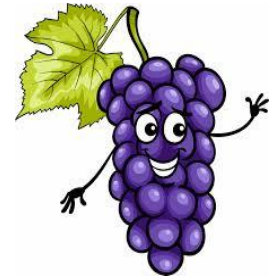

STEM

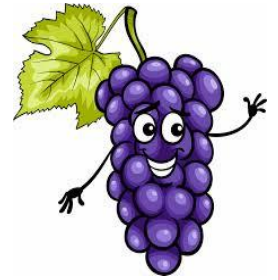
