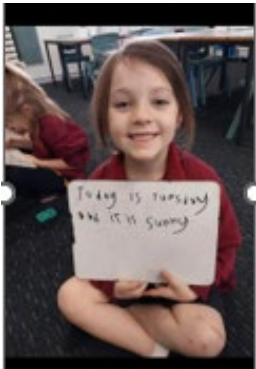
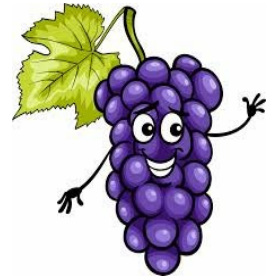

Mrs Coleman's dance group took the stage and performed a fabulous routine. 🎭 Well done girls...Great job!

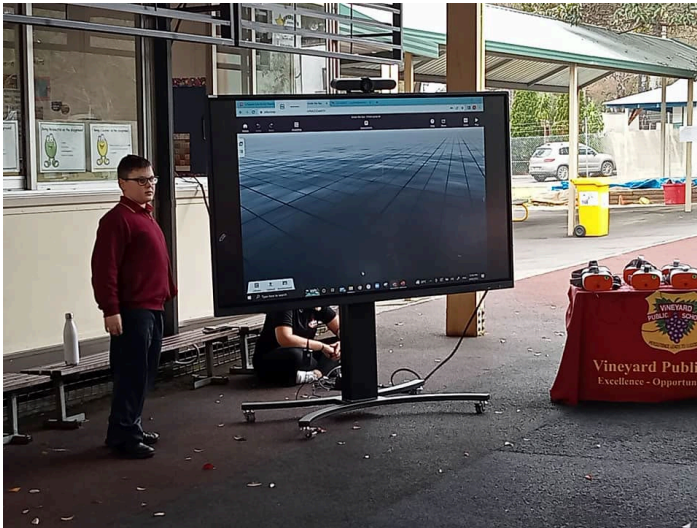
