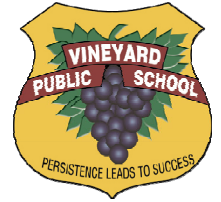

Check-in Assessments

Year 6 students will participate in online reading, writing and numeracy Check-in Assessments during regular class time in Weeks 8-10 this term. Years 3-5 will complete their Check-in Assessments at the start of Term 4. This assessment supplements existing school practices to identify how students perform in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to students' needs. This information also provides the school with valuable data to best enhance the teaching and learning programs used throughout the school. As the Check-in Assessment is a diagnostic assessment to inform teaching, there are no official parent and carer reports available.
